Discussion of the Week

Time is beginning to fly by now as we continue our planning for the transition between the end of this term and the start of next. Bikes and scooters

It has been great to see the shed and racks so full of different vehicles, enabling children to travel to school in ways which help to keep them fit but also keeping cars off our roads and helping us to be courteous to our local neighbours. Thank you for your help with this. Last Friday however, I was made aware of a group of children from our school who were riding unsafely down a nearby road, without helmets or care and attention for the traffic. Please can I take this opportunity to ask that you remind your children of road safety. Also, please use the routes into school on the paths, thereby not cutting through the school car park. Additionally, it would be useful to remind children to walk with their bikes and scooters from the gate so that people walking and waiting are also safe.

Parent Feedback

Following discussion with both governors and senior staff, I have been asked to feed back the summary to you all from the parent survey. In total there has been an approximately 15% response rate from our parent community, the results of which are summarised in the table below. Governors are keen for me to share that this is not therefore fully reflective of everyone's views and doesn't enable us to identify clearly what our future areas of focus and improvement will be, and how we will be able to make effective changes to improve. In order to continue to work together with you, children and staff will also complete the survey before the end of the year and the findings will be compared so that we can consult everyone in our community. I will therefore prepare a copy of the survey to go out for each family so that if you have not had chance to cast your views, you will be able to do so.
