



Year 1 Home Learning Letter – 06.05.20

Phonics	 <p>Today we will be looking at the long 'o' sound made with 'o_e'.</p> <p>Can you see the o_e sound in the words below?</p> <p>How many sounds can you hear in each word? Can you hear the o_e sound?</p> <p style="text-align: center;">home nose bone smoke</p> <p style="text-align: center;">throne telephone antelope envelope</p> <p>Ask a grown up to read the word. Can you write the word? You could write a sentence. You could draw pictures for each word and play snap to see if you can match it to the word.</p> <p>Letters and Sounds lessons are being shown daily on YouTube.
