


Welcome to the 20th week of 2020! Each day we are going to give you a 20 challenge - can you complete them all? Today's challenge: Can you do 20 press-ups?

<p>Spelling</p>		<p><i>The mole rode down the slope to his home.</i> Write out your sentence. Challenge words: envelope telephone antelope Can you use different colours for the o_e in each word?</p>		
<p>Reading</p>	<p>Write a new title for a book you read and loved – how would you keep the title linked to the content of the book? When you have completed 15 minutes of reading today, pick 3 of your books. Can you think of a better title for these books? Why have you chosen these titles?</p>

<p>Handwriting</p>	<p>Strength challenge – Push down on your heels to push you bottom up. Can you squeeze a cuddly toy between your knees at the same time? How long can you hold the position for? Then hold each animal position for 1 minute: penguin, meerkat, gorilla, lizard. Write a word for each of the slider family letters.</p>
