


## Year R's Home Learning Letter (Monday) 18.5.20

<b>Writing</b>	<p><b>Draw a picture of Bob on the moon.</b>  <b>Write a sentence about him. Where is he? What he is doing? Who is he with?</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Don't forget to snuggle your letters into words, leaving gaps between them.</li> <li>• Use the sound and word mats in your learning pack.</li> </ul>	
<b>Handwriting</b>	 <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Practise the letter b from the Jumper family</b></p>  <p style="text-align: center;">See information in pack for more guidance.                  Practise words <b>be but bed back</b></p>	<p>“Down-bump. Back up. Push over. Pull in (along the ground and hug the tree).”</p>
<b>Maths</b>	<p>Talk about the different times that Bob does things in the story, The Man on the Moon. Talk about how this compares to when you do things. What do you do in the morning, afternoon, evening.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Refer to the clock at different times of the day (keeping to o'clock times). What do the children notice about where the short hand is pointing.</li> </ul>
