

Spelling	<p>Rule: Words from the Year 5/6 Statutory Spelling List.</p> <p>Spelling sentence: <i>The people of the world took the opportunity to communicate with loved ones, take some leisure time and support vulnerable neighbours.</i></p> <p>Practise this week's spelling sentence. Try to use a range of different techniques over the week to help you remember the spellings. You could try breaking the word into syllables and then segmenting the phonemes (the sounds) within a syllable.</p>
Reading	<p>Spend at least 30 minutes reading a book today. Perhaps you could perform a short section to someone at home.</p> <p>We're going to look at some non-fiction texts this week. This is an extract from <i>Secrets of the Dragon World</i>, which is written in a non-fiction style. Find the answer the following questions in the text:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • What does 'herbivorous' mean? • How do we know that male Triceratops used to fight each other? • What are the advantages of prey animals moving in herds? Give two advantages from the text. • The text tells us that Triceratops remains are "usually found individually, suggesting they may have spent much of their lives alone."
