Talk about what your-self read sentences mean. Re-read them at pace, then explain them.

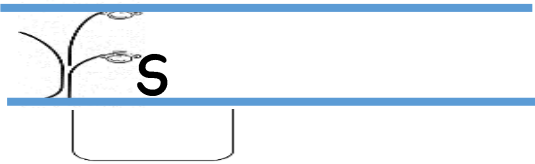
Writing:

Maths:

Number recognition and number stories.
