Then Scared monkey discovered that he could dangle his tail in the water to catch to fish.</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Draw a picture with Scared monkey's tail hooking out the fish.</li> <li>- Which letters have a tail which hooks out the fish?</li> <li>- Draw the tree at the beginning of a line and then practise a line of starting at Scared monkey: down, on down, pull around to make a tail</li> </ul> </div> </div>
