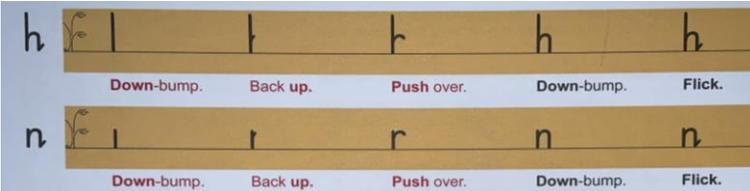


Year 3 Home Learning Letter – 31.03.20
