Challenge your adult to blend together your sounds in any 3 sound words. E.g. n ight t.

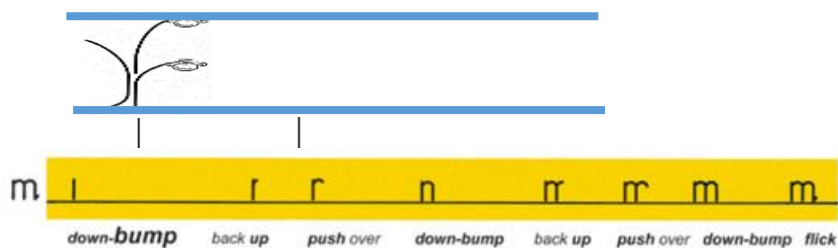
Writing:
